

Job Description - Ski Patroller

The objectives of this position include, but not limited to:

Patrol

- Complete pre-opening & post-closing terrain hazard management
- Monitor ski area terrain, during the operational day, ensuring hazards and terrain are marked and managed in regard to patrons safety
- Ensure there is a qualified first aid response for patrons and staff on the Ski Area
- Be available and on call for any medical incident
- Maintain patrol stock and equipment
- Ensure all applicable paperwork is completed immediately
- Inform the public of any issues related to terrain or lifts
- Coordinate and work with any Volunteer Ski Patrol members as required
- Assist with management of the volunteer Patrol roster and ensure there is clear understanding of expectations and roles of staff, patrol and volunteers

Outdoor Operations

- Operate the ski area lifts and terrain in a safe manner for patrons and members at all possible times
- Ensure all lifts are maintained and operational in conjunction with the Mountain Manager & maintenance staff
- Ability to open and close lifts
- Ensure lift track, loading and unloading areas are maintained to give patrons the best experience
- Ability to repair and maintain lifts with the assistance of the mechanical team
- Ensure lift ticket checks are carried out daily

Snow Safety

- Support the Snow Safety Officer and the Snow Safety programme
- Assist in any Snow Safety function as requested
- Take all possible steps to control and minimise Avalanche hazards using current industry standards whilst maintaining the safety of staff and patrons at all times
